

## Suggestions for presenters

How and what you present, will depend on time constraints and the technology you have available. Below are suggestions based on time constraints:

- 5 minutes – Show the video [What is ARDF Canada?](#) (4 minutes) – Note that this video illustrates the project ARDFC undertook in the Diocese of Kindu, Congo in 2011.
- 10 minutes – Show several videos OR speed through the PowerPoint presentation
