FIGHTS POVERTY AND MALNUTRITION: 3rd Term covering the period of 26th May to
25th August 2016**

1. NARRATIVE REPORT

To ARDF: We are pleased to report from the project in course now of **FARMING INITIATIVE FIGHTS POVERTY AND MALNUTRITION**

In this 3rd term, we have been able to carry out the following activities:

As East Africa loses about 1.3 million hectares of forest cover each year and Burundi ranks 20th in the world for highest rate of deforestation, losing 3 per cent of its forest cover each year,

The first activity in this third term was to establish tree nurseries for agro-forestry in each locality of action for reforestation in order to care and conserve the environment. Seeds of useful trees such as trees that put nutrients in the ground for fertilizing the soil, trees that give shade and also some timber and firewood have been sown.

The Diocesan Secretary has visited from one of the association of Kiryama when they were packing the mud in bags. They plan to make a tree nursery of 20.000 tree seedlings.

-The 2nd activity was to trace trenches on the hills to avoid the environment degradation. Hitherto, they have already traced 47 km. To encourage them, we gave each person a package of 10kg of beans





-The third activity was to provide 60 goats to 3 other association groups of Kiryama, Sanzwe and Kiremba. Some Pastors have participated in the distribution of the goats.





TESTIMONY

We are too much thankful to the Anglican Church of Burundi; Diocese of Muyinga for supporting us with the goats that will give us manure to fertilize our soil hopefully that we shall improve on the production .These goats after their multiplication shall give us income to pay for our children's school fees, food and healthcare, thus fighting poverty.
