## **Suggestions for presenters**

How and what you present, will depend on time constraints and the technology you have available. Below are suggestions based on time constraints:

- 5 minutes Show the video <u>What is ARDF Canada?</u> (4 minutes) Note that this video illustrates the project ARDFC undertook in the Diocese of Kindu, Congo in 2011.
- 10 minutes Show several videos OR speed through the PowerPoint presentation Videos (in the following order)
  » ARDF: What does it mean to be Anglican? (2:24 minutes)

<u>» How can we actually help the poor?</u> (1:43 minutes) <u>» What is ARDF Canada?</u> (4 minutes)

## Presentation (11 slides)

PowerPoint presentation [link to PPT] Presentation in pdf form [link to pdf of PPT] Presentation speaking notes [link to pdf of PPT with speaking notes]

- 15-20 minutes Show one video first followed by presentation
- 30 minutes Show 2 videos first then present the slides. And allow time for questions at the end.

- These videos are produced by our partner, ARDF, so with the exception of the video What is ARDF-Canada they promote the ARDF website.

- Videos can be downloaded to your computer to facilitate showing. You may need to ask your parishes resident techie for help!
