FIGHTS POVERTY AND MALNUTRITION: 2nd Term covering the period of 26th
February to 25th May 2016**

1. NARRATIVE REPORT

To ARDF: We are once again delighted to report from the project in course now of **FARMING INITIATIVE FIGHTS POVERTY AND MALNUTRITION**

This 2nd term, we have been able to carry out the following activities:

We have provided selected seeds of beans, potatoes and maize to Farmers groups to run three farmers field schools respectively in Kiremba, Kiryama and Sanzwe. In this 2nd term we have also provided them with cuttings and goats. There are 6 groups working together in Kiremba, 8 groups in Kiryama and 6 groups in Sanzwe thus 20 groups in total working together in those three localities. Each group has therefore received 5 goats from which the use of their droppings as manure will improve on the fertility of the soil for beneficiaries and their neighbors then increase crop production in the area.
